**About Us:**

Manatee Eye Care, LLC is a privately owned eye care practice that serves patients in the retail space. We are a small local practice that will be expanding into a brand-new storefront location in Lakewood Ranch, FL (still under construction; ETA is December 2023).

**Opportunity:**

**About the Position:**

This contract position offers full-tech support, which will allow you to focus on patient care. As strong advocates of positive work-life balance, the working hours are 9-5 or 10-6 (location specific) with a full hour for lunch. There will be flexibility built into the schedule rotation after hiring decisions are made and preferences are reviewed. At this time, we expect a 3-day and 4-day weekly rotation with no Sundays.

- Diagnose sight problems, such as nearsightedness or farsightedness
- Prescribe eyeglasses, contact lenses, and medications
- Evaluate patients for the presence of diseases such as Glaucoma, Cataracts, Macular Degeneration, Retinal Disorders etc. & refer patients as needed
- Promote eye health by counseling patients, including explaining how to clean and wear contact lenses
- Dry eye care
